

EU, UK, UN, US and US

It could not be prolonged further. The western Christian colonialism has decided to punish us for defeating the most ruthless terrorist group known to the world other than of course the western powers themselves, which was supported and sponsored by the west. They still continue to support Tamil racism against the Sinhala people using the Tamil diaspora. The so called panel to advise the secretary general of the united nations on human rights conditions in Sri Lanka has been appointed almost simultaneously with the EU deciding to withdraw the GSP plus in respect of the imports from Sri Lanka to those countries. However, one has to realise that this is only the beginning. Sooner than later economic sanctions would be imposed on us by the west. The western Christian colonialism will never forgive Sri Lanka for defeating their darling the LTTE as the terrorist organisation had been used by the former against the Sinhala Buddhist culture as well as the Sri Lankan government.

Some people would question as to the abilities of the Minister of external affairs and the “big shots” in the ministry. It was only a week ago some so called educated people were praising the minister Peiris for all the “good work” he had done in US. What the Sri Lankan “educated” people would not understand is that in these matters the individuals play a very insignificant role and it is usually their mistakes and blunders that the western Christian colonialism would exploit when it comes to performance by the individuals.

Once upon a time one Ronnie de Mel was praised as one of the most eloquent brilliant ministers of finance that we have ever had, and the funds he obtained from the west, very often as loans, were shown as ample testimony to the high regard the finance minister had among the western leaders. We knew it was nothing but bullshit but there was no way even to demonstrate that it was not the case. We were lucky and soon D B Wijethunga became the minister of finance. He had no pretensions and did not waste the time of the parliament by quoting Shakespeare and others and his budget speeches were very short. Moreover he had been able to get funds from the western countries even more than what his predecessors had obtained. The individuals matter very little in international politics and it is the forces that represent various movements that finally resolve these matters.

There is very little that the ministers of external affairs could do by their eloquent speeches and neither the ambassadors. However, they can damage the position of the country as evidenced by the so called performance of G L Peiris in US and by ambassador Kohona’s acceptance to serve on a committee on Israel. It appears that the only purpose of appointing this committee was to justify the appointment of the “panel” to advise the secretary general of UN on human rights conditions in Sri Lanka. What we want in the western capitals are ambassadors who can argue with the agents of western Christian colonialism on what is known in Sinhala as “keththata polla” basis. It is not that the argument would win the case for Sri Lanka but it will make the agents of western Christian colonialism ridiculed. The minister of external affairs should be able to call a spade a spade without resorting to the so called diplomatic language. It should be remembered that people are not convinced by argument but by change of attitude and it

takes years to change the attitude of a person. In the twenties and thirties two great minds Einstein and Bohr argued on the interpretation of Quantum Mechanics none being able to convince the other. As Max Plank another Physicist has observed new ideas are accepted only because the older generation pass away in the process. In the case of countries and nations conviction comes as a result of applying force economic, political or otherwise and definitely not by force of argument.

If we gain anything at these international bodies, fora it is not due to the eloquence or the diplomatic language or the good mannerisms of the boys and girls who represent us in them but due to the political support we get from the non western lobby. If not for Russia, China, India, Iran and in general the old non aligned body we would be no where in spite of the best Sunday suits and the western aping manners of those who represent us at the “hallowed” hollow international bodies. What these worthy gentlemen and ladies have to do is to organize the non western countries by having a good rapport with them. Unfortunately it has now become the duty of the President Mahinda Rajapakse himself in spite of his enormous duties that he has to attend.

Recently it was published in the newspapers that the prospective brides and bridegrooms who intend to go to UK to get married to citizens of that country should have a knowledge of English. Now we know that English is only one of the languages used in UK and there are Welsh, Irish and Scottish beside English even if one ignores Arabic, Chinese, Hindi and let us say Tamil, languages used by millions of people. The English would point out that the latter are languages of the immigrants but could they say the same in respect of Welsh, Irish and Scottish. It is easy to see that compared to these three languages even if one disregards languages used in Cornwall and other such places, English is the language of the immigrants to England. The English who have established their hegemony in the so called UK are in a position to ask the prospective brides and bridegrooms to learn English and not Welsh, Irish or Scottish.

There are some priests in Sri Lanka descending spiritually from the English who find the slightest excuse to advise the Sinhala, meaning of course the Sinhala Buddhists, on reconciliation and other matters. They forget how the English treated the losers in the wars the latter won including the so called two world wars though they were not our wars. The Sinhala have always done much better than the English or the Americans or the other westerners in this regard from the days of Gemunu to the days of Mahinda (Rajapakse). No country would have looked after three hundred thousand “refugees” and settled down them in comparably a very short time. If Sri Lanka had a language policy similar to that of UK what these priests who descend spiritually from English would have done is not something that has to be left to imagination. They would have gone to town with slogans such as discrimination of the Tamil language, Sinhala Buddhist supremacy, but unfortunately in UK the priests are silent and so are the human rights bandwagon. In fact they have forgotten that there are people in UK who speak Welsh, Irish or Scottish.

The Sri Lankan government should not worry too much on the hypocrisy of the westerners. The UN and its secretary general are only puppets (pambaya sounds better) of western Christian colonialism that has changed its instruments of suppression and

oppression over the years. We do not have the GA's who derived their power from the British raj in our small towns anymore nor the white governors and the colonial office in London. However, the united nations have replaced the colonial office with the secretary general replacing the colonial secretary, albeit being in a puppet of US and other western countries. The puppet as a person may be powerless but being a puppet of US and such countries the UN general secretary "exercises" powers of his masters. Instead of the all powerful GA's we now have NGO and INGO agents and the media boys and girls who defend the human rights of the darlings of the western powers, who are in essence the agents of western powers. Just as much the GA's derived their power from the British raj, the NGO, INGO, media freedom agents derive power from the western Christian colonialism.

Let us briefly state the instruments used by western Christian colonialism at present. Though nobody else may agree with me it is firstly the knowledge created in the Greek Judaic Christian Chinthanya during the last five hundred years or so together with classical knowledge in Mathematics and Science "created" in Greece. This knowledge is imposed on us through the preschools, schools and the universities in the guise of a so called objective knowledge. The Aristotelian Newtonian Einsteinian ontology with a realistic or positivistic epistemology as the case may be depending on the taste of the individual dominates current thinking in the whole world. The so called human rights which are in essence human rights in the Judaic Christian culture are used as if they are objective human rights, in order to weaken the cultures other than western. The Tamils who are being used against the Sinhals have certain human rights which the Palestinians do not have. The Muslims in the western world are not allowed to wear their traditional dresses under the pretext of safeguarding the human rights of the Caucasians. Multiculturalism is interpreted as "equiculturalism" in the non western world. Multiculturalism should mean the recognition of different cultures but not equality of cultures. The individuals may be equal before law (theoretically in the western world and the countries that follow the western system as lawyers are not equal) but cultures are never. In the west they have dominant, prominent cultures among the existing cultures that are recognized. However, in Sri Lanka the westerners and their agents want to interpret that kind of multiculturalism as equiculturalism without even giving the status of the significant culture to the Sinhala Buddhist culture.

Then we have the United Nations which we have mentioned earlier. UN at present is used by the western world as a manipulative tool to maintain western Christian colonialism. The NGOs and INGOs created about twenty years ago are being financed mainly by the western governments in spite of the nomenclature and are nothing but tools of western Christian colonialism. They are established in the so called third world in order to propagate the western point of view and to brainwash people even by bribing them with insignificant material benefits at very low cost for the western world. The various organisations such as free media, human rights have been established in order to speak for the western view when necessary.

Even the smaller countries such as Norway work on behalf of the powerful western countries as could be seen during the LTTE days. Now Norway has taken a back seat and

US and UK have taken direct control of the machinery against Sri Lanka. The GSP plus withdrawal clearly shows how the west use economic sanctions and conditions to control non western countries, and it was a blunder by the Sri Lankan government to sign the agreement as apparently only five countries have signed such agreements. Some of the conditions laid down by the EU are similar to those by the LTTE and no government can agree to release LTTE terrorists even for millions of Euro.

The government should not listen to these terrorists in the west who resort to terrorist methods in the absence of their pet terrorist tigers. It is heartening to note the government has taken correct steps with respect to UN as well EU and the possibility of bringing a no confidence motion against the UN secretary general should be explored.
